The Speaker of the House of Representatives.

SIR: Section 22 of the act of March 3, 1909 (35 Stat., 795), authorizes the Secretary of the Interior to reserve all lands within the Flathead Indian Reservation, Mont., chiefly valuable for power and reservoir sites, and provides that he shall report annually to the Congress all lands reserved for such purposes.

During the fiscal year from July 1, 1914, to June 30, 1915, the following withdrawals were made in connection with the Flathead

project for reservoir and construction purposes:

T. 21 N., R. 21 W., NE. ½ NW. ¼, NE. ½ SW. ¼, S. ½ SW. ¼, SW. ½

SE. ¼, section 27; N. ½ NW. ¼, SE. ¼ NW. ¼, W. ½ NE. ¼, section 34.

This comprises all lands reserved for power and reservoir purposes

withdrawn for the Flathead project during the last fiscal year.
